Postmortem examination is an art of disease diagnosis by systemic dissection, recording of gross pathological lesions, and their correlation with history by a veterinarian and is a message from the dead to the living. Postmortem is valuable part of disease investigation and is necessary for effective control of animal diseases and will usually answer the question, "Why did the animal die?"

Postmortem examination has significant importance in the context of veterolegal cases and for settlement of claims for insured animals. Postmortem also helps to advance scientific knowledge in various areas of research and development. Conducting and recording postmortem examination will also give the veterinarian valuable experience and information that may aid in diagnosis of future cases. The objective of this training is to highlight the importance of postmortem examination, challenges faced by field veterinarians, to guide veterinarian on precautions to be taken along with available resources on postmortem techniques, steps in postmortem examination, determination of time of death, postmortem lesions of important diseases etc.
